If you are keen, **it's a good climb** of 30-40 minutes.

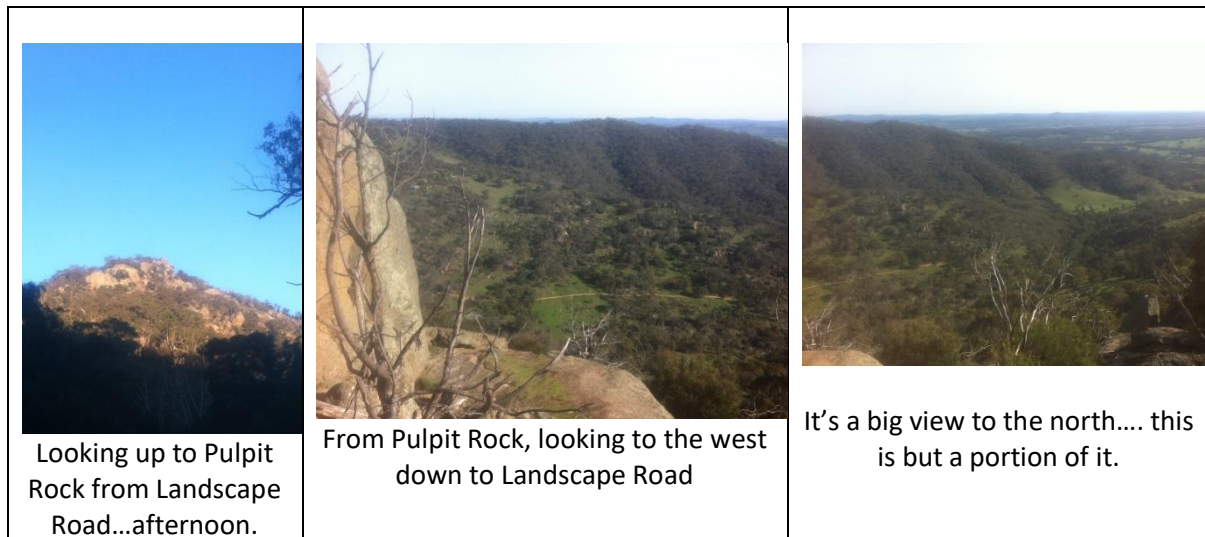
If you do not want to climb, a 4WD taxi will carry you in style - 25minutes to the Rock.

Directions to 750 Landscape Road. From Tallarook along the Upper Goulburn Road (to Yea) about 3 km then first right after the bridge> Landscape Road, gravel road. Proceed straight past a house on the left, a house on the right (cattle grid), down a gully then climb up and past the second cattle grid, and up a concrete section then left at 50m. This is 750. If you get lost, - ring Peter
